April 7<sup>th</sup>

From Spring St. to Cudworth to Salem and all  
streets inside these boundaries

Thursday  
April 8<sup>th</sup>

From Central Ave. to Fellsway West to Forest Street  
to Cypress Road. All streets inside these boundaries

Friday  
April 9<sup>th</sup>

From Fellsway West to Salem Street to  
Winslow Avenue

line. All streets inside these boundaries

From Winthrop St to High St. to railroad tracks. All  
streets inside these boundaries

Friday

From railroad tracks to Mystic Valley Parkway to  
Harvard Ave. All streets inside these boundaries
